In exchange for a subsidized trip, all participating teachers will be required to complete a short program evaluation based on their experience at CMOST.

Applications will be processed on a first come, first served basis and can be submitted immediately. Highest preference will be given to schools that offer a higher percentage of free or reduced lunches, Title I schools and schools that are more than 60 miles round trip away from The Museum.
