Measure, Mix & Munch

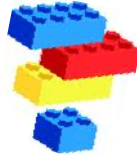
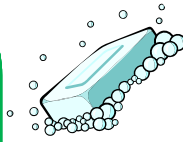
Where does our food come from? How does it change when it's cooked? Be a science chef and cook up a storm while making new discoveries about everyday food science.
